Directions

From junction 22 of the M1 take the A511 west signed Ashby/Coalville. Then straight over the 1st traffic island. After 1.5 miles fork left at the next traffic island onto the B585 signed Ellistown. Left at the next island signed Newbold. Follow this road for 1.5 miles to T junction. Turn left, and continue straight on for 1.5 miles into Bagworth. Bagworth Working Mens Club is on the right.

Event Area

The 75-hectare site is on the location of the former Desford Colliery and is owned and managed by the County Council, This is maturing into a good area, with mixed terrain and vegetation, including lakes and several hills.

Maps

Scale for White and Yellow Courses will be 1:5000
All other courses will use scale 1:10,000
All printed on waterproof paper.
Brown course will be printed double sided.

Maps for White and Yellow courses will be available at registration All other maps at the start.
Loose Control descriptions will be available at registration.

Car parking

Is at the Bagworth working Men's Club, Station Road, Bagworth, LE67 1BJ
There is limited parking at the club. When the club car park is full you will be asked to park along the adjacent roads. DO NOT BLOCK ANY ACCESS OR DRIVEWAYS.
We ask competitors to consider car sharing.

Refreshments and bar will be available in the club house

Electronic Punching

All courses will use SPORTident. Hire charges for dibbers £1:00 per person.
The event will be a punching start.

Safety

Short Green, Green, and Blue courses have a road crossing. The Brown course has 3 road crossings. These road crossings will not be marshalled nor will they have a time out section. Please take care when crossing this road.

Entries

Entry on the day only. Seniors £6.00 Juniors £2.00
Dibber hire £1.00 - £30.00 for lost dibbers

Registration and start

Registration is in the Bagworth Working Men's Club from 10:00 to 12:00
Start from 10:30 to 12:30

The route from the car park to the start is 1.2km. Along the road on foot paths to the south end of the village. There are two road crossing, one crossing is opposite the car park and not marshalled, the other crossing is to the south side of the village. This will be marshalled.

There will be a Clothing dump, about 200m from the start.

Finishes

There are two finishes East and West.

The White, Yellow, Orange, and Light Green courses use the East finish. The route from this finish back to the car park follows the start route in reverse.

The Short Green, Green, Blue and Brown courses use the West finish. From this finish, cross over the road to join the return route from the start.

All courses close at 2:30pm.
