 - We made a small gain overall of £2,032. Taking into account the accumulated fund brought forward from 2017, the accumulated fund carried forward is £13,588. We expect to make a loss of circa £1,500 in 2019.

Open forum:

- Roger Phillips: communicated the proposed changes for the 2019 Compass Sport Cup.
- Chris Phillips: there have been discussions in the Region to introduce the M75 urban class.
- Chris Phillips: there have been discussions in the Region to reduce the number of events from 5 per club to 4 due to the difficulties in finding locations and event officials.
- Ernie Williams: LEI 50th Anniversary could we run an event as close as possible to the date and time of the first LEI event? Peter Hornsby confirmed the first LEI event was at Bradgate Park in September.
- Peter Hornsby: The Outdoor Show will be shown on BBC2 Scotland at 7pm on 4th November 2018, part of which was filmed at the British Long Championships at Balmoral.
- Christmas Novelty event is on Saturday 8th December at Castle Hill.
