Controllers Comments

I was pleased to be controlling an event where Peter Leake was Planner. Peter is a competent planner and is particularly concerned with getting the best out of an area. I think he achieved that today.

We were set quite a tight time schedule to complete the necessary work. I know I had problems finding time to inspect Peter's control sites and at this time of year, the bracken is becoming a bit of a problem with some of the features. I made a couple of suggestions to improve the courses, which Peter took on board.

We did have one rather unfortunate upset on the Light Green course, with control 5 being marked incorrectly on the master maps. The actual control was about 50 metres east of the incorrectly marked location. I re-marked the correct position on the master maps at about 11.20 a.m., so all those running after that time had the correct location. To the rest of you, well, I know how annoying and frustrating it can be when there is an error on a course. We are, of course, very disappointed it happened and sorry if it made your run less enjoyable. I have discussed the incident with the event officials and have agreed that those that ran the Light Green course prior to the re-marking of the master map, be compensated. With electronic punching it would have been easy to invalidate that leg for everyone, but as it was traditional punching, we have had to take a calculated decision on what compensation to give you.

I did hear one or two comments about there being no Green. I think the Club needs to consider whether the right combination of courses was offered, not an easy decision at a limited colour coded event.

Thanks to Laurie for his efficient organising and also to Severn Trent Water for the use of their gracious old pumphouse and grounds.

Bradgate is a good area to plan on but it does present its own problems. One of which is knowing just how quickly the bracken is going to grow.

Without the bracken controls become visible from a great distance. In order to prevent this I tried to place controls as low as possible ensuring that competitors had

to find the feature before they found the control.

I hope you enjoyed your courses. I was pleased to hear competitors on the blue course discussing their various route choices. Looks like I got something right! We can only apologise for the problem on the light green course with control 5. My original planning had the control where marked on the master maps which was a control more suitable for light green. I know some competitors found the tape at this point. I hope they continued without delay. Others I fear searched around until they found the control with the correct number originally planned for the blue course only. I know some later starters with the control correctly marked had difficulty finding this control. If this had been a Gallopen or other important event the course would have had to be voided.

With such a large area it takes a long while to put out and collect controls. My thanks go to the one anonymous orienteer from club unknown who gave a little of his time to collect a few controls.

I do hope that you avoided the ticks that I managed to pick up. However I did spend a lot longer in the bracken than any competitor.
