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| Getting there and parking: | <p>Conkers Discovery Centre, Rawdon Road, Moira, Ashby de la Zouch Postcode: DE12 6GA. SK 310161. Parking is free.</p> <p>Please slow down along Rawdon Road as you will encounter orienteers crossing the road from either direction.</p> <p>If the weather has been severe prior to the event, or is forecast to be severe, please check back at the LEI website / facebook page to check the event is running.</p> |
| Safety PLEASE READ: | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• There is a main road to cross on the way to both starts and on the way back from the finish. <u>You are asked to follow the guidance of crossing marshalls</u> as they may have a better view of the road.• Parents are advised to accompany children to their start, and to shadow them on the course if they are inexperienced.• Please take care in the car park, and stick to footpaths where possible.• There are a number of water hazards on the courses, as well as a footbridge which may be slippery.• Avoid crossing fences as most have barbed wire.• Whistles are strongly advised.• Goggles are advised if the weather is wet or cold.• Competitors must wear clothing that fully covers the torso and legs. Shorts are not permitted.• Please wear suitable footwear. You can expect uneven and muddy or slippery terrain, especially if the weather is wet.• Please be courteous to other members of the public, dog walkers etc. that you encounter.• A risk assessment has been carried out by the organiser and all reasonable care has been taken by the Organiser and Planner to ensure the safety and well-being of competitors. However, competitors are responsible for their own safety during the event.• Please let the organiser know of any significant pre-existing medical conditions. |

| Terrain and map: | <p>Runnable open land and Woodland.</p> <p>Recently revised map (2022). 1:10000 with 5m contours. Please note there are forbidden routes and areas which are out of bounds, which are marked on the map.</p> <p>Special symbols: Black cross for a tripod (affects short green, green, blue and brown courses)</p> |
| Timing: | <p>The event will use Sportident (Si) electronic punching.</p> <p>SIAC battery test will be available in the car park at the beginning of the route to starts.</p> <p>Contactless (SIAC) is enabled, but note you must physically punch start and finish controls.</p> |
| Starts and start times; distances | <p>Please ensure you start with plenty of time to complete your course before courses close.</p> <p>Start locations and times vary according to course</p> <p>Near Start - for White, Yellow, Orange and Light Green. Open 10:45 – 11:45 and located 700m from the car park.</p> <p>Far Start - for Short Green, Green, Blue & Brown. Open 10:30 – 12:30 and located 1.7km from car park so please allow plenty of time to walk up.</p> |
