Compass Sport Cup & Trophy Qualifying Round

- Venue:** Chetwynd Coppice & Brereton Spurs, Cannock Chase
- Date:** Sunday 18th February 2024
- Directions:** Signed from A460 Rugeley to Hednesford Road, on the edge of Rugeley, Stile Cop Road to the south. Stile Cop Road is also signed for "Stile Cop Cemetery". The postcode of the cemetery next to the lane entrance to the parking field is WS15 1ND. Area as used for JK 2018. GR: SK 038162
- Parking:** Lane entrance is "Coppice Lane" (What3Words: hello.shuttered.change), then in a well-drained field as for the JK2018.
Dogs are permitted.
- Registration and Entry:** Pre-entry for all CSC & CST courses only. On the day only for non-CSC & non-CST courses - White, Yellow, & Light Green from 10.00 to 11.00 am (£5 adults, £2 juniors) but pre-entry for these preferred.
- Start Times:** 10.20 to 13.00 Hrs.
- Entry Fees:** Pre-entry for the Compass Sport courses on form sent out to club captains or nominated reps: Seniors £15, Juniors £5. SI card hire is free.
(Please note that the event needs to cover three separate access fees.)
- Punching:** SportIdent with mixed electronic punching, i.e. SIAC or traditional dibbing.
- Competition:** Compass Sport Cup and Trophy regional round. Beginners are welcome.
- Courses:** As in the CSC competition rules.
- Map:** Map as used for 2021, surveyed Dave Peel in 2018, recent updates 2024
Scale 1:10,000, 5m contours. Pre-marked maps on waterproof paper.
- Terrain:** Mainly runnable wood, but with undergrowth and brashings in some parts. Southern area includes well contoured series of spurs and re-entrants.
- Facilities:** Toilets, first aid, Podium Catering, other traders may confirm.
- Safety:** The area includes Chetwynd Coppice which in the past has had mining operations, especially on the east side. Two known shafts are fenced off. The area can be subject to subsidence.
Whistles must be carried. Full leg cover is needed.
- Safety and Risk:** A risk assessment will have been carried out by the organiser, but participants take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety during the event.

- Cancellation:** WCH reserve the right to retain part or all of pre-entry fees to cover costs.
